This `old vine` Chardonnay is super fresh and lively with a lovely twist of lemon acidity. A beautifully unoaked and fresh which is balanced and dry. The palate is full of white peach and apple flavours and develops exotic fruits such as pineapple, banana and quince on the palate. A good structure with a fresh acidity leads into a lingering finish.

Well-balanced, food-friendly wine with medium body and light bright characteristic fruit flavours of apricot and peach. Aromas of exotic fruit with hints of almond and honeysuckle on the finish.

The palate is full with notes of exotic fruits with ripe grapes and stone fruits. The weight and the rich bread-like character are added by aging the wine over winter on it's lees leaving a silky mouth-feel. 100% Melon de Bourgogne.

Dry silky white wine is made from a selected harvest of the ripest 100% Chenin Blanc grapes avoiding any botrytis to retain an intense and pure fruit. This Vouvray Sec is partly fermented in oak barrel to contribute a subtle vanilla character that enhances and mingles with melon and pear flavours balanced by citrus acidity.
- ²⁴⁷ **Sancerre, Domaine André Neveu, Calcaire, 12.5%** **56.00**

Made from 100% Sauvignon Blanc grapes grown on the limestone slopes of Bué, this is a classic with a lovely grassy aroma and well balanced ripe flavours. Whilst exuberant to start, with citrus flavours, there is excellent balance and full sweet fruit on the finish.

Fermented spontaneously using the grapes ambient yeasts and aged in stainless steel vats to preserve the delicate and pure aromatics of the variety. On the nose, preserved lemon, lime flesh and white peach is complimented by a strong slatey minerality.
- 252 **Sauvignon Blanc, Bodegas, Pinuaga, Organic, 12.5% 2022** **36.00**
Bright straw colour with tropical aromas of melon and papaya, and as it opens more subtle herbal notes. Fresh and juicy palate, with bright citric notes of white grapefruit and balanced acidity.
- 266 **Verdejo, José Pariente, Rueda, 13% 2023** **42.00**
Grassy and floral with good acidity making a fresh wine with a characteristic slight bitterness and oiliness. On the palate - herbal, mineral with a finish of tropical and citrus fruits. A classic example of the variety.
- 269 **Chardonnay, Xarel-lo, Xa, Xa, Xa, Can Vallès, 12.5% 2022/2023** **46.00**
This easy drinking white is made of a blend of Xarel-lo (pronounced charel-lo) and Chardonnay combining fresh bright fruit and texture. It shows pleasant notes of fresh citrus, pear and apple on the nose, and on the palate gives silky velvety texture to complement the lively acidity and fresh flavours.
- 415 **Albariño, Pazo Señorans, Rias Baixas, 12.5% 2024** **49.00**
Aromas of nectarine, fresh figs, orange zest and white flowers. Dry, citrus flavours and a mineral-driven finish, which expands and deepens on the tail end. Balance of power and finesse.
- 267 **Verdejo, Barrel Fermented, José Pariente, Rueda, 13.5% 2021** **59.00**
Bright and golden yellow to the eye, it has an intense, complex nose, its aromas spicy, slightly smoky, with ripe fruit and a hint of wood. There are also notes of exotic fruits and minerals. In the mouth it is voluminous, unctuous and very elegant. Powerful, with a good acidity that ensures a long and lively passage. It presents a great balance between fruit and wood. Everything that is perceived in the nose appears again in the mouth.

Notes of green apple, conference pear and pineapple combine with the classic pepperiness of Gruner Veltliner, all underpinned by a fresh and zesty acidity.

⁷⁴⁷ **Vinho Verde, Azal, AB Valley Wines, 12.5%** **38.00**

A light and zesty white from Northwest Portugal. Has delicate floral and citrus notes on the nose. The palate is very fresh with a zingy acidity and notes of green apple, white peach, grapefruit and a hint of elderflower. 100% Azal Branco.

Armenia

²⁷⁷ **Zorah, 'Voski', 13%** **64.00**
2019

This wine has generous aromas of pear, peach and apricot, with subtle nutty hints. It has a rich texture and a beautiful freshness on the palate, supported by a soft minerality. 'Voski' is made from equal portions of native varieties Voskéat and Garandmak. The grapes are planted on their own roots and are grown in an old village at 1,400 metres above sea level. The name Voski means 'gold' in Armenian. The wine is unoaked and has a lovely intensity of perfume, great depth on the palate and lovely length.

India

²⁸² **J'Noon, Akluj White, 13.5%** **54.00**
2020

J'NOON is a joint venture between Kapil Sekhri of Fratelli wines and Jean-Charles Boisset. The name is a French take on the Urdu word 'Junoon', which means 'passion'. The wines are selected from the Fratelli vineyards in Akluj (Mahārāshtra), on the right bank of the Nira River about 170 kilometres south of Pune. The still wines come from vineyards situated at 650 metres above sea level in Garwar. The cool nights ensure the grapes retain perfume and acidity, while the sandy soils with a high rock content drain well and are low in nutrients, ensuring highly concentrated fruit.
